Prevedemos que dichas obras durarán alrededor de cuatro meses.

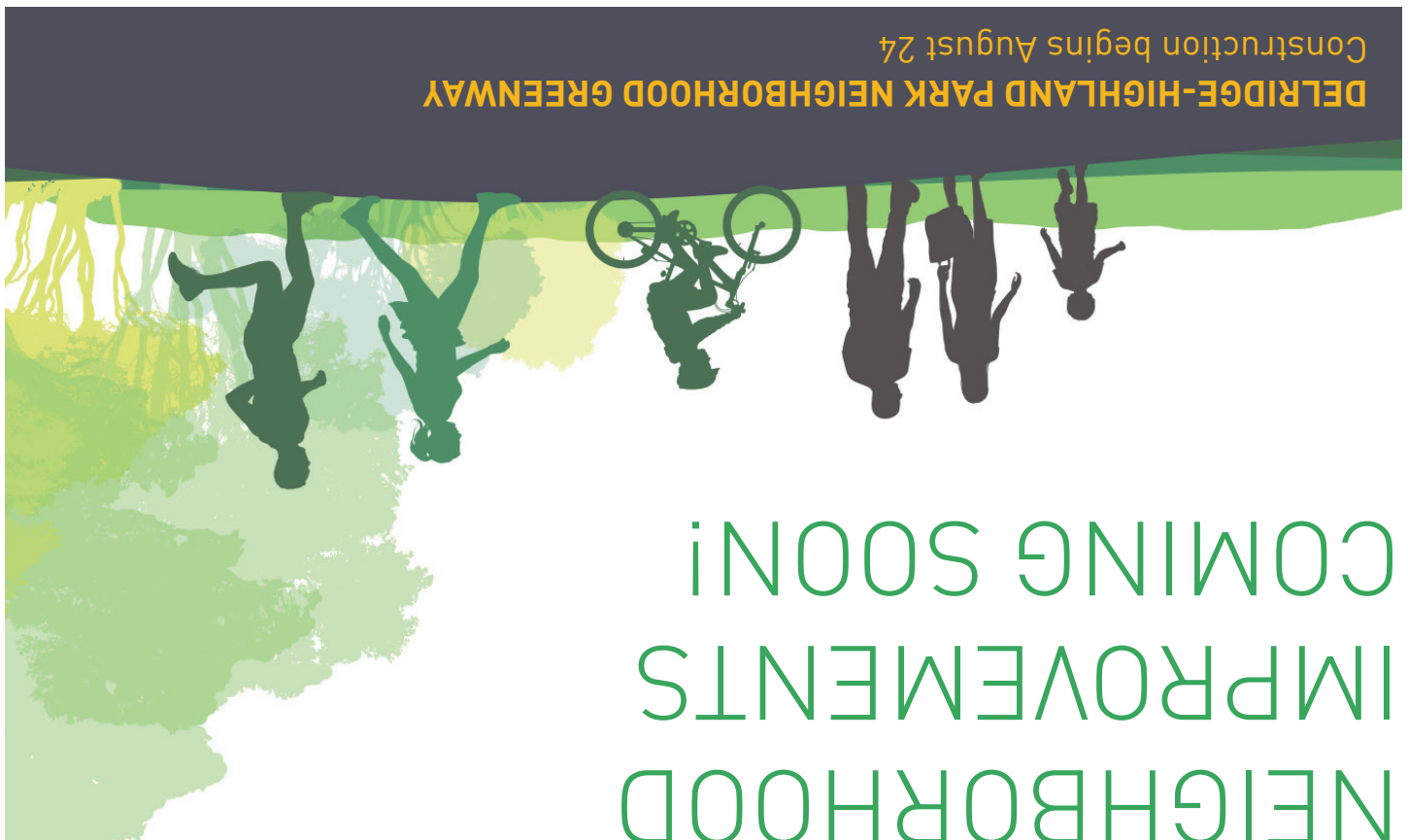

CONSTRUCTION BEGINS ON AUGUST 24

On August 24, the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will begin constructing improvements to make it safer for people to walk, bike, and drive in the neighborhood.

We are committed to keeping the community informed and will notify residents in advance of driveway closures. Contact us at DelridgeGreenway@seattle.gov to receive email updates. Work is expected to last approximately four months.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Temporary on-street parking restrictions
- Short-term single lane closures, where needed
- Pedestrian and bicyclist detours
- Noise, dust, and vibration typical of construction
- Weekday work hours from 7 AM to 4 PM
- Maintained driveway access to residences

ELEMENTS OF THIS GREENWAY INCLUDE:

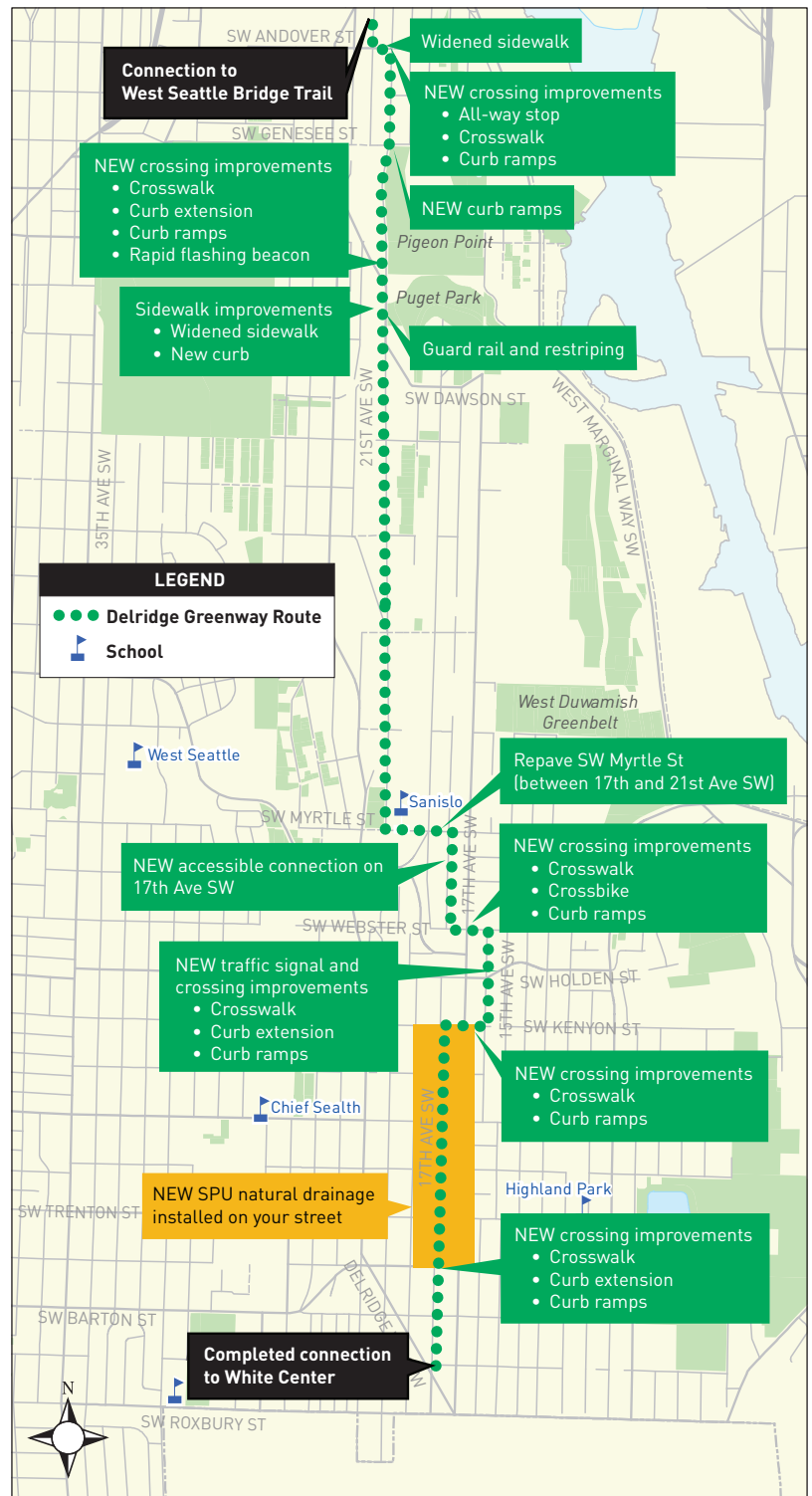
- Speed humps and all-way stops
- Pavement markings and signage
- Wayfinding signs
- Crossing improvements, including new signals, crosswalks, and curb ramps
- New accessible connections
- Spot pavement and sidewalk repairs

SEATTLE PUBLIC UTILITIES (SPU) NATURAL DRAINAGE WORK
