

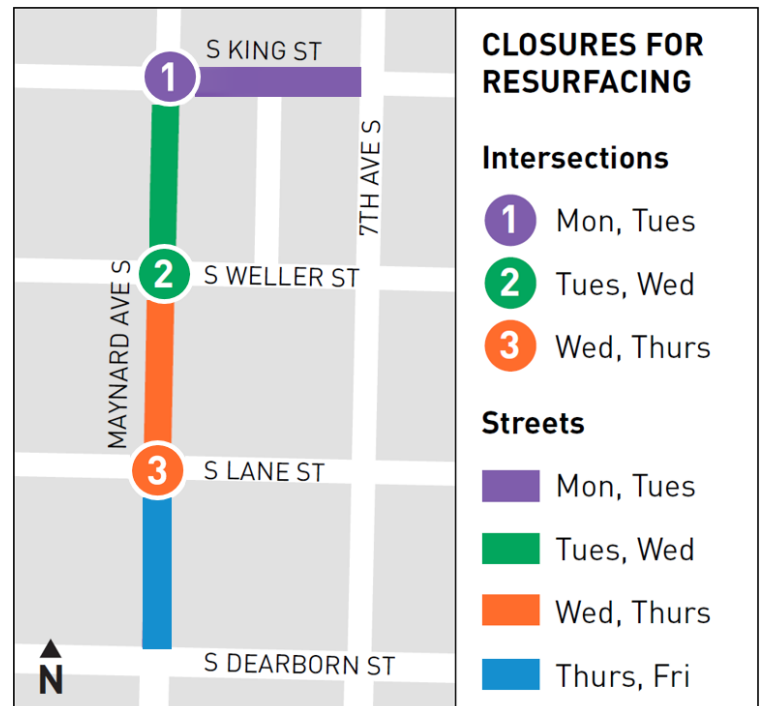
# PAVING NOTICE

## Maynard Ave S from S Dearborn St to S King St and S King St from Maynard Ave S to 7<sup>th</sup> Ave S

Mon. March 5<sup>th</sup> to Fri. March 9<sup>th</sup>\* 7AM – 4PM

\*Weather permitting

- SDOT will grind off the top two inches of pavement from sections of the street and then repave them.
- Each block and each intersection will be closed 7AM – 4PM for two work days.
- On-street parking will be restricted when a block is closed for resurfacing. 72 hours before work starts “NO PARKING” signs will be placed along the impacted blocks.
- Detour signs will guide people driving.
- Sidewalks will remain open at all times.

# PAVING NOTICE

## Schedule and Details for resurfacing Monday March 5 through Friday, March 9.

- When a block is closed for resurfacing:
  - there will be no on-street parking on that block
  - all lanes of the block will be closed to through traffic
  - access to businesses or homes on the block will be maintained, but vehicles may have to wait up to 15 minutes to enter the block.
  - SDOT will store equipment overnight on the block that was closed earlier that day. SDOT will use half of the on-street parking on one side of that block.
- When an intersection is closed for resurfacing:
  - no traffic will be allowed to pass through the intersection
  - there will be no parking within 2 parking spaces of the intersection on streets adjacent to the intersection. (This is required for the work zone.)

This resurfacing project will make the streets smoother and more comfortable to use and will support the future S King St Neighborhood Greenway. Greenways make streets safer and calmer for everyone.
