Reduced Cost Transportation Programs

Affordable ways for you to travel by transit, bicycle, or car.

ORCA LIFT

- With an ORCA LIFT transit card, most transit trips in Seattle only cost \$1.50
- Enroll at Columbia Public Health Center (4400 37th Ave S, Seattle, WA 98118), open Monday - Friday, 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM (closed from 12:30 PM to 1:30 PM)
- Eligibility: proof of income qualifications and residency to present at time of enrollment:
 - ONE income eligibility document such as: Provider One Card (Medicaid), EBT Card, DSHS Award Letter, or pay stubs from the last 30 days
 - ONE form of identification such as: state ID card, permanent resident card, or passport

Spin Bike

- Try one of Seattle's new bike share services
- Purchase half-priced Spin Access cards from Bike Works (3709 S Ferdinand St Seattle, WA 98118) open Monday - Thursday, 12 PM - 7 PM and Friday - Sunday, 11 AM - 6 PM

- Each ride up to 30 minutes only 50 cents
- Eligibility: must present your ORCA LIFT card at time of purchase

City of Seattle's \$20 Car Tab Rebate

- Get a \$20 rebate on your car tabs
- Eligibility: meet income qualifications (same as the Utility Discount Program), have a car registered in Seattle, and have paid for your car tabs

Discounted Restricted Parking Zone (RPZ) Permits

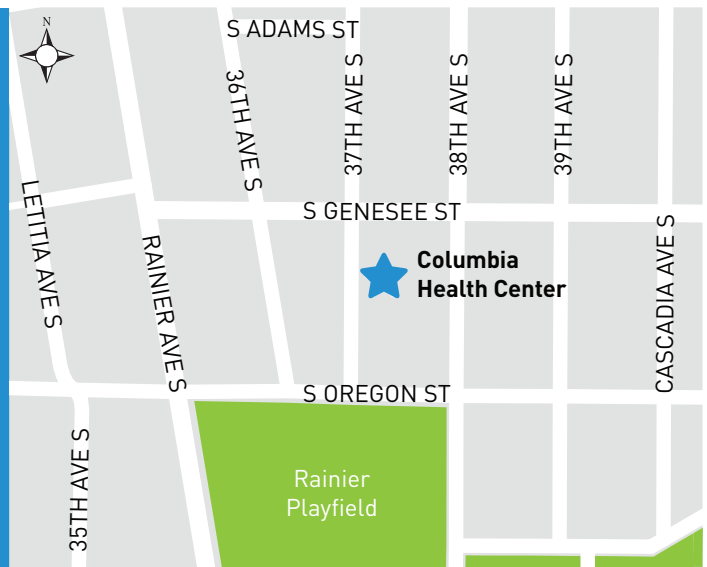
- Get a discounted \$10 RPZ permit (compared with \$65 fee)
- Eligibility: proof of residency in an RPZ and ONE income eligibility document including, but not limited to: SNAP card, enrollment in City of Seattle Utility Discount Program, lease/rental agreement from a low-income housing provider
