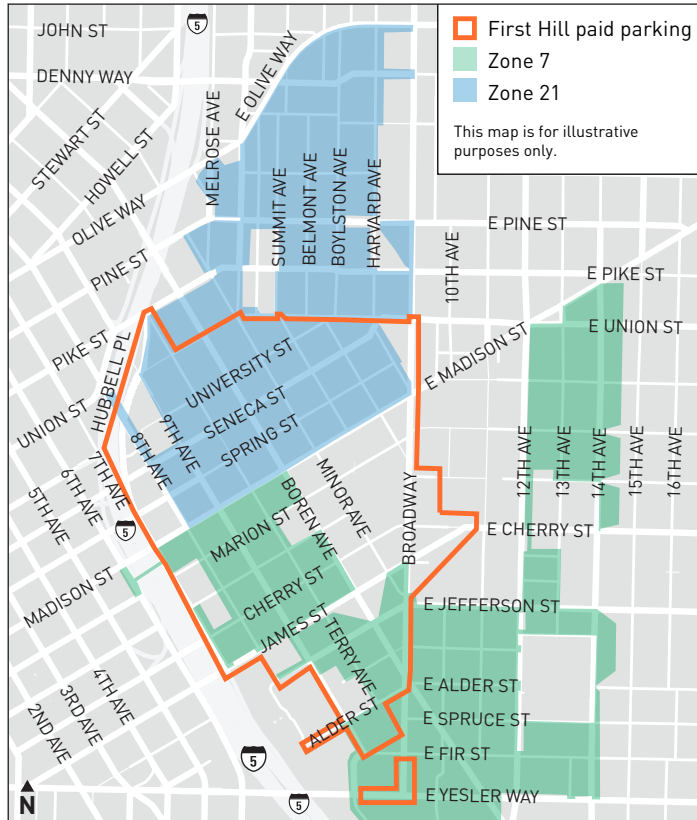


Where Can I Park with a Restricted Parking Zone 7 or 21 Permit?

Updated August 2024

Restricted Parking Zones (RPZs) 7 and 21 overlap with the First Hill paid parking area. This means that there are some blocks in each Zone that are both paid and RPZ. Restrictions vary from block to block. Please check the posted signs on the street to ensure you are properly parked.



If you have an RPZ Zone 7 or 21 permit, you can park without paying or complying with the posted time limits next to signs that indicate your zone number.

If you park on a block and don't see a 7 or 21 on the paid parking sign, you must observe the posted time limit and pay the posted rate.



RPZ signs for Zone 7 and 21 (below) are on non-paid blocks and indicate that you can park without observing the posted time limit.
