

WHERE CAN I PARK WITH A RESTRICTED PARKING **ZONE 4 PERMIT?**

On the map below, the blue lines show where you can use your Restricted Parking Zone (RPZ) 4 permit. In the orange box, residents are eligible for permits, but can only use their RPZ permit on these streets between 10 PM and 8 AM. SDOT made changes last fall that prioritize loading and customer access, rather than long-term residential parking.

Finding zone parking can be difficult because parking demand is greater than the parking supply. Space is not guaranteed. Some residents find paying for off-street parking in a garage or lot is the best way to guarantee you have a place to park your car.



RPZ signs for Zone 4 (shown below) are on non-paid blocks and indicate that you can park without observing the posted time limit.



If you see a paid parking sign (shown below) you must observe the posted time limit and pay the posted rate.
