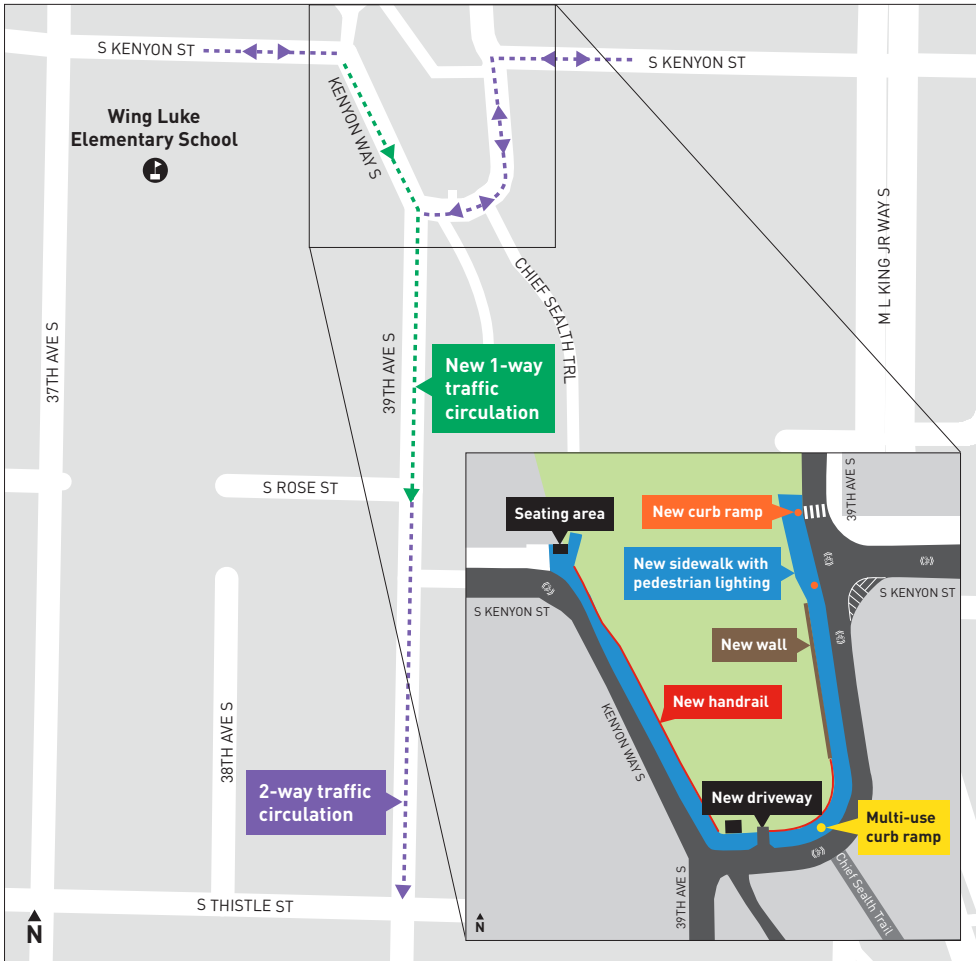


# KENYON WAY S SIDEWALK PROJECT

We are prioritizing this location to fill a gap in the sidewalk and bicycle network that will help kids walking and biking to school and to create a more comfortable and safe connection to community destinations.

Project elements include:

- Installing a multi-use sidewalk with handrails and pedestrian lighting
- Building new curb ramps including a multi-use curb ramp to connect the Chief Sealth Trail
- Creating two new seating areas on Kenyon Way S

The final sidewalk design will require changing a portion of Kenyon Way S and 39th Ave S from two-way to one-way traffic circulation once the project is complete (see map on other side for details).
