Pioneer Square Parking Restrictions

Some roadways in Pioneer Square have weight baring limits that are not be able to accommodate large production vehicles or trucks. Please consult <u>this website</u> for up-to-date information, maps of restricted roadways, and more.

Because of these restrictions, and the public safety hazard they present, any productions filming at *any* locations in Pioneer Square that will be parking <u>and/or</u> unloading vehicles larger than a personal vehicle <u>must submit a full detailed list of vehicles that will be present at the shoot a full 5 business days</u> <u>before their shoot date. Last minute vehicle additions submitted after the 5 business day window will not be accepted or approved.</u>

This list must include the following information for all vehicles:

- Make and model
- Vehicle type (box truck, cube truck, RV, etc.)
- Empty Vehicle weight
- Estimated weight when filled with equipment
 - Please provide list of equipment, or what category of equipment will be in vehicle (ie. wardrobe, grip, etc.)
- Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR)

This list must be submitted in addition to the permit application and site maps required with your <u>Film</u> <u>Permit Application</u>. The document can be uploaded under the "Additional Documents" section of the application. Please consult the "Curb Spaces" tab of <u>this map</u> to find available parking spaces.

Once submitted, your materials will be submitted to our SDOT partners for review to ensure vehicles entering the area comply with weight limit restrictions. If they do not, your request for parking will be denied, and the production will need to seek our alternative parking at private locations.

Any vehicles over the weight limit found parking in restricted areas are subject to fine and revocation of film permit and potentially future permits applied by individual or company.

It is the location manager or production companies' responsibility to communicate these guidelines with all drivers and crew ahead of any shoots in the Pioneer Square neighborhood.






Pioneer Square Neighborhood Outline

Any productions submitting film permit applications for shoots (with vehicles larger than personal vehicles) within the green outlined area must submit a detailed vehicle list.




PIONEER SQUARE AREAWAY ASSESSMENT AND REPAIR; LOAD ZONE LOCATIONS
