








Enter Seattle's Neighborhoods Portal



Urban Centers and Villages

Urban Centers and Villages are areas designated in Seattle's Comprehensive Plan to accommodate future population and job growth. These areas were adopted as part of the 1994 Comprehensive Plan to help guide land use and transportation policies.



Council Districts

In 2013, Seattle voters passed a measure amending our City's Charter to establish City Council Districts. In 2015, voters will elect seven out of nine City Council members by district.



Community Reporting Areas


Community Reporting Areas (CRAs) were established in 2004 as a standard, consistent, citywide geography for the purposes of reporting census related information. There are 53 CRAs composed of from one to six census tracts.





PUMAs

A PUMA (public use microdata area) is a census area that comprises at least 10,000 people and is the smallest geography for which annual American Community Survey data is available.




