

For EMERGENCY maintenance hole access, immediately report floods, overflows, and backups to Seattle Public Utilities (SPU), 24/7 Operations Response Center at (206) 386-1800.

For non-emergency access to an SPU Maintenance Hole to survey, clean or inspect a sewer or drainage line, contractors are required to notify SPU.

Please complete and submit this form to <u>SPU_DWW_Pipe_Rehab@Seattle.gov</u>.

After the form is received, an SPU representative will contact you within two business days to provide you with the necessary approval and permission to access the maintenance hole to conduct any needed drilling, grouting or concrete construction.
