- 2. Top-loading clothes washers in common areas eligible to be replaced with front-loading models.
- 3. <u>Complete the application</u>, return via email to <u>melissa.levo@seattle.gov</u>, by fax, or mailing address listed below, along with the rent-roll for the building, the regulatory agreement for non-profit status & W9.

- 5. Wait until you receive an authorization letter before proceeding. Select qualifying toilets (and clothes washers if applicable). Contact supplier to make delivery and scheduling arrangements, and select your plumber.
- 6. Install new toilets. You must replace all (pre-2004) toilets in the building with Premium 1.1 gpf (or less) toilets. (See list at www.savingwater.org/rebates).
- 7. Complete your project and submit Completion Form and receipts for toilets and installation (with breakdown of price of toilets, accessories and labor) to the address above. **Project must be completed within authorized timeframe in authorization letter.**
