


Seattle Public Utilities Water System Synopsis as of August 29, 2022



Little precipitation was recorded in the Cedar River and South Fork Tolt River Watersheds over the past week.



The average snow accumulation across the sites that we monitor is estimated to be about 0.0 inches which is the same as the long term median for this time of the year.



Note: WY = Water Year, which is defined as the 12-month period October 1, for any given year through September 30 of the following year. The water year is designated by the calendar year in which it ends. Thus, the year ending September 30, 2021 is called water year 2021 (WY 2021). Long-term water consumption data uses the most recent 10-years of data in order to better capture recent reductions in demand due to SPU's conservation program efforts.
