Many of the anticipated future users of the site have allergies to common urban plants. In an effort to minimize allergic reactions, plant and tree selection is based on a low-allergen species mix.

Allergy ratings for each plant is based on the Ogren Plant Allergy Scale (OPALS) which ranks potential to cause allergies in people based on 130 different possible factors. Some of these include:

- The amount of pollen produced (if any)
- The potency of the pollen
- How much of the year the plant is in bloom
- The size of the actual pollen grains
- The specific gravity of the pollen grains

- How sticky or dry the grains are
- Whether the tree is perfect flowered, monoecious, cioecious, or polygamous
- Whether the sap causes dermatitis
- Whether the smell of the flowers bothers people
