Project Overview

We're completing the sidewalks along Greenwood Ave N to fill key gaps between N 112th St and N 117th St, and N 134th St and N 137th St. This final phase will include new sidewalks, curbs, planting strips, a future upgraded pedestrian signal, and ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act)-compliant curb ramps, ensuring safer and more accessible routes for all users.

This project represents the culmination of years of effort to transform Greenwood Ave N into a safe, connected, and accessible corridor. These enhancements will make it easier for residents to walk, roll, and reach schools, transit, businesses, and community destinations. By improving safety and accessibility, we're fostering stronger connections within our neighborhood and encouraging active travel for people of all ages and abilities.
