- Schedule R is available to all customers, including but not limited to water and sewer districts and King County, who contract with the Department for dusk-to-dawn lighting of streets, alleys, and other public residential thoroughfares.
- Schedule A is available to all customers, including but not limited to water and sewer districts and King County, who contract with the Department for dusk-to-dawn lighting of arterial thoroughfares.
- Schedule D is available to all customers, including but not limited to water and sewer districts and King County, who contract with the Department for dusk-to-dawn lighting of streets, alleys, and other public and pedestrian thoroughfares which utilize decorative, non-standard lighting.

CONTRACT STREET AND AREA LIGHTING RATES (cont.)

4. Schedule M is available to all customers who own lighting fixtures that are maintained and powered by the Department, including but not limited to water and sewer districts and King County, who contract with the Department for dusk-to dawn lighting.
5. Schedule E is available to all customers who own and maintain lighting fixtures that are powered by the Department, including but not limited to water and sewer districts and King County, who contract with the Department for dusk-to-dawn lighting.
6. Schedule F is available to all customers, including but not limited to water and sewer districts and King county, who contract with the Department for floodlights operating from dusk to dawn.
7. Schedules R, A, D, M, F and E are for unmetered lighting only.
